There are two outstanding payments related to the website. The Raffle Quilt brought in \$2716.80. A motion by Juanita, seconded by Diantha to approve the November Treasurer's Report was made. All in favor.

Sherri said the blessing and delicious potluck was enjoyed by all.

Sherri announced that the deposit for the Haw River 2025 sewing retreat is now due. She announced some upcoming programs for the year. She thanked her board and presented them with gifts of appreciation. Juanita presented Sherri with a thank you gift for being our president this year.
