High Point Quilt Guild Meeting Minutes August 10, 2023

President Kelly called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm welcoming members and guest.

Membership - Karen introduced our guest, Angie. Angie's nephew was diagnosed with cancer and the Guild graciously donated a charity quilt to him. August birthday wishes were given.

Minutes for July 13, 2023 - Diantha - A motion by Nancy, seconded by Wendy to approve the July 13, 2023 minutes was made. All in favor.

Treasurer's Report, July 2023 - Alicia - The Treasurer's report was emailed to the membership on 8/6/23. Beginning balance \$12,899.27, no outstanding checks, ending balance \$15,544.26. A motion by Juanita, seconded by MaryBeth to approve the July 2023 Treasurer's Report was made. All in favor.

Spring Retreat - President Kelly told the membership that the Board discussed at their July meeting the fact that member's interest in a Spring Retreat had fallen. It was recommended that the issue be brought before the membership, as our Bylaws require that we have a Spring Retreat, and an Amendment would have to be made. The membership has decided they prefer the Saturday Sit-and-Sew held after our regular meetings January through September to the Spring Retreat.

Amendment Thirteen: (Article VII - Amendment Seven). This Amendment removes the wording "and organizing a Spring Retreat" from the First Vice President's responsibilities.
