Vice President Juanita called the meeting to order at 6:30pm welcoming seventeen members and two visitors, Jean and George. Happy birthday to three members.

A motion was made by Diantha, seconded by Alicia, to approve the minutes for October. All in favor.

Treasurer's Report - Alicia - The October Treasurer's Report was emailed to the membership on November 9th. There are outstanding payments, including the 25 Fall Retreat deposit. Deposits \$379.00, checks cleared \$3,767.12, ending balance (including outstanding payments) \$16,324.20. A motion by Janet, seconded by Susan to approve the October Treasurer's Report was made. All in favor. Alicia gave an update of the Raffle Quilt. We are still selling tickets and have \$2,511.80 so far. Thanksgiving holiday is a great opportunity to sell tickets to family and friends. Please return all unsold tickets to the guild meeting in December, as this is the date for the drawing.

Elections – Susan announced our nominees and passed out ballots. First Vice President nominee is Karen, no nominations from the floor. Second Vice President in charge of Membership nominee is Jeanne, no nominations from the floor. Treasurer nominee is Sherri, no nominations from the floor.
