HPQG Quilting Cotton Fabric Swap July 11th – during our Guild Meeting

Please note – this fabric swap is a freebie exchange – no money needed because nothing is being sold.

Come join us for a fun 100% quilting cotton fabric swap in July. This swap is designed to help change out your fabric stash to replace pieces you are done with and bring in new options.

Categories for the Fabric Swap:

□ Half Yard (between 18" and 35" by WOF)

□ 1 Yard (between 36" and 53" by WOF)

□ Yard and a half (between 54" and 71" by WOF)

 \Box 2 Yards (72" by WOF)

□ PRE CUT Bundles – complete original sets of:

o Jelly Roll (40 - 2.5" strips)

o Honey Bun (40 – 1.5" strips)

o Junior or Mini Jelly Roll (20 - 2.5" strips)

o Layer Cake (42 - 10" squares)

o Charm Pack (42 – 5" squares)

o Mini Charm Pack (42 - 2 1/2" squares)

o Fat Quarter Bundle (18" x 21" – at least 5 required)

o Fat Eight Bundle (9" by 21" - at least 5 required)

Tables will be set up for each category – please put your fabric onto the correct table. Except for the

Bundles, which are required to be LIKE FOR LIKE, all yardage fabric is on a first come, first serve basis – so feel free to start taking what you like as soon as you drop your fabric off on the tables.

Rules:

□ All Fabric is required to be 100% quilting cotton – no duck cloth, canvas, felt, flannel, polyester,

stretch, cotton blends, or other non-cotton fabrics.

□ All Fabric (outside of bundles) is to be standard 42-44 inches wide (WOF) – no 108" fabrics.

□ All Fabric is required to be full pieces – no scraps, no cut out shapes, no missing corners, etc.

□ All Fabric is assumed to be UNWASHED – if washed, fabric must be marked either WASHED or W

□ All Fabric is assumed to come from a SMOKE FREE home. If smoking allowed in home, fabric

must be marked SMOKING or S

□ All Fabric is assumed to come from a PET FREE home. If pets are allowed near fabric, then fabric

must be marked PETS or P

□ All Bundles are required to be the original, complete set with the plastic wrapper or ribbon or

paper strap, etc. OK to not have original label/price tag.

□ FOR BUNDLES ONLY – these are to be EXACT like for like during the swap, so you can only take a certain type of bundle if you brought one to swap (e.g. Jelly Roll for Jelly Roll).

o Note for Fat Quarters & amp; Fat Eights: does not matter the #, just the same type.

□ For yardage, does not matter how much you brought, as long as you brought some to swap,

take as much yardage as you like throughout the swap. Again, it is first come, first serve.

□ Please do not bring any other items not included in the Fabric Swap categories above, including

but not limited to: quilt kits, fabric scraps, books, tool, notions, single fat quarters, single fat

eighths, fabric that is more than 2 yards in length, 108" backing fabric, etc.

At the end, everyone will have the option to pick up any BUNDLES that they brought that did not get swapped. After that, all remaining fabric will be collected and donated.

Please note – this fabric swap is a freebie exchange – no money needed because nothing is being sold.
