October 12, 2023

Minutes - September 14, 2023 - A motion by Juanita, seconded by Janet to approve the September 14, 2023 minutes was made. All in favor.

Treasurer's Report September 2023 - Alicia - The Treasurer's Report was emailed to the membership on October 5, 2023. Beginning balance \$11,792.36, three outstanding checks, ending balance \$11,597.78. A motion by Susan, seconded by Melanie to approve the September 2023 Treasurer's Report was made. All in favor.

Alicia also announced that we have paid for the Northwoods meeting space (including sit and sew) for the first six months of 2024. The 2024 Sit and Sew days will be held on the Saturday after Quilt Guild from January through September.
