January 13, 2022 Meeting Minutes - Secretary Diantha Dann - Nancy Blanchard made a motion to except the the January 2022 minutes as submitted. Seconded by Angie Peele. All in favor.

January 2022 Treasurer's Report - Treasurer Sherri Fields - The January 2022 Treasurer's Report was emailed to the membership on February 5, 2022. Beginning balance \$16,332.19, cleared payments \$2,005.09, deposits \$270.00, outstanding checks \$350.00. Ending balance \$14,247.10. A motion by Angie Peele, seconded by Mary Beth Pazdernik to approve the January 2022 Treasurer's Report was submitted. All in favor.

Membership - Karen Tooley - At this time, we have 27 members. Karen has completed the updates to the HPQG Member Handbook and Bylaws and will contact Alicia Carter to have it put on the website.
